Three scholarships will be awarded for 2022, one for each Henry County High School: Abbeville High School, Headland High School, and Abbeville Christian Academy. Each scholarship awarded will be for \$750.00. All are gift scholarships and not loans.

RULES

Candidates for this award shall be a daughter, son, grandson or granddaughter of veterans who served in the Armed Forces.

Applicants must be in their senior year of high school.

The winner of any other locally awarded American Legion or American Legion Auxiliary Scholarship is not eligible.

Participation in this scholarship program shall be on a voluntary basis.

The scholarship must be used within 12 months of the date the winner receives notification by the American Legion or American Legion Auxiliary. If the monies awarded are not used they will go back to the scholarship fund for future awards.

Applicants must complete 25 hours of volunteer service within the community during their senior year. Hours must be verified on the attached chart by the recipient organizations.

Applicants must present the completed application to the local American Legion Post 119 or Auxiliary Unit by April 8, 2022. The winning entry shall be announced at the awards program of each school at the end of the school year. Each school will be advised of the winner within five (5) days of their award program, and a letter of instructions on how to receive the scholarship will be enclosed with the award certificate.

The decision of the judges shall be final. The judging teams for each school will consist of one American Legion member and two American Legion Auxiliary members, not affiliated with the school they are judging.

The award will be paid directly to the winner's school of choice upon adjutant's notification by the student. If the student does not register within 12 months the scholarship will be forfeited.

APPLICATION PACKET REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Completed application packet for Bradley-Keller Post 119 American Legion / American Legion Auxiliary Scholarship.
- 2. The following four letters of recommendation are required:
 - a. One letter from either the principal or guidance counselor of the school from which the applicant will graduate, to include size of class and the cumulative grade point average.
 - b. Three letters from a clergyman/clergywoman of the applicant's choice or from adult citizens, other than relatives, attesting to the applicant's character in regard to conduct, citizenship and leadership.
- 3. An original essay consisting of no more than 1,000 words (typed, double-spaced). The title of the essay will be: "What veteran has impacted your life? How will you use this impression in life?"
- 4. The completed chart verifying 25 hours of voluntary service during the senior year of high school.
- 5. A certified transcript or photocopy of the applicant's high school grades.
- 6. A copy of ACT or SAT test scores.
- 7. A copy of the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) form, or a copy of the FAFSA Summary Report and Confirmation Page, or the FAFA Student Aid Report (SAR).
- A brief statement of the military service of parent or grandparent, including the branch of service and dates of service, and a photocopy of parent's or grandparent's DD 214 discharge form. Documentation of military service and honorable discharge is required.
