

2022 Henry County Cattlemen's Association Scholarship

Eligibility Rules

The Henry County Cattlemen's Scholarship was established by the Henry County Cattlemen's Association Board of Directors in 2013 to aid selected students each year with a one-time \$500 stipend to further his or her education. The following criteria have been established for eligibility:

- 1) The student applicant must be a graduating Senior of a Henry County High School or Home School Accredited Program and/or live in Henry County;**
- 2) The student applicant must have a GPA of a minimum of 3.0 average (Mandatory);**
- 3) The student applicant must be attending a college in the Fall of their graduating year;**
- 4) The student applicant must be recommended to the Scholarship Committee by his or her school counselor, principal, teacher or equivalent;**
- 5) The student applicant must be involved in community service or affiliated with a service organization (4-H, FFA, FHA, church youth organization...etc.)**

It will then be forwarded to the Scholarship Selection Committee to be judged on merit. Multiple winners will be selected each year.

The selected students will be awarded the Henry County Cattlemen's Scholarships at the Annual Cattlemen's Banquet in February. (TBD) To receive the \$500 stipend the recipient must register and pay for fees, tuition, books etc....for the fall semester in college of their graduating year. Proof of enrollment must be presented to secretary/treasurer of the Henry County Cattlemen's Association to be reimbursed.
